**BOARD TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST TWO LICENSED CONTRACTORS**

*(Reno, NV)* – At its meeting on July 9, 2003 the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated cases against two (2) licensed contractors.

---

*Sierra Earth & Stone*, license number 49668 (Excavating, Grading, Trenching, Surfacing) based out of Reno, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to pay for materials or services; failure to cooperate in the investigation of a complaint; failure to establish financial responsibility; and failure to retain qualified employee. The Board revoked the license of Sierra Earth & Stone.

*Serva Pool*, license number 46716 (Commercial and Residential Pools) based out of Reno, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to establish financial responsibility; failure to include license number and monetary limit on a contract or proposal; failure to provide required disclosures; failure to provide disclosures pertaining to the Residential Recovery Fund; and failure to comply with pool and spa regulations. The licensee was fined \$1750 and assessed the cost of investigation.

*The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.*
