## NSCB Cautions Nevada Contractors of Out-of-State Solar Manufacturers Looking to Hire for Installation Services

**HENDERSON and RENO, Nev.** – In recent months, the Nevada State Contractors Board (NSCB) has been seeing an increase in the number of out-of-state solar manufacturers entering into contracts with licensed Nevada contractors to perform solar installation services for Nevada residents. Many of the out-of-state manufacturers do not possess a Nevada contractor's license and the Nevada contractors performing installation services for such businesses are being disciplined by the Board for aiding and abetting an unlicensed contractor.

NSCB wishes to caution solar and electrical contractors and the industry at large of such contracts and to always verify that the entity being contracted with is a licensed Nevada contractor.
