

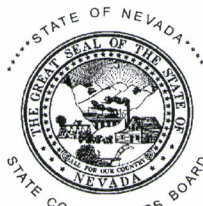

ALJ Allison found Respondent guilty one (1) violation of NRS 624.3015(1) acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3016(8) failing to pay an assessment required by NRS 624.470; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NRS 624.520(1) failure to provide Residential Recovery Fund notice to owner; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(4) failure to keep in force the bond for the full period required by the Board; and one (1)
