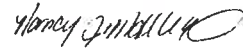

**ADJOURNMENT**

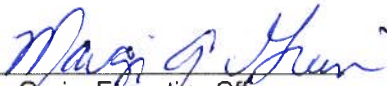
There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned by Acting Chair Cavin at 11:00 a.m.
