

HOMEOWNER ADVISORY

The Nevada State Contractors Board (NSCB) is advising homeowners, who are interested in qualifying for Nevada Power's High Efficiency A/C Rebate Program, to have their contractor explain the program's guidelines and standards to them. Both the homeowner and contractor should check with Nevada Power to make sure an AC unit meets the criteria of the program. Nevada Power will only give rebates if air conditioning units meet specific SEER and EER criteria. Some high efficiency A/C units may meet the SEER qualifications, but not the EER criteria. Rebates can range from \$70 per ton for Tier 1 units to \$325 per ton for Advanced Tier units.

However, if <u>both</u> SEER and EER criteria fail to meet the program's guidelines, homeowners <u>may not</u> qualify for the Nevada Power rebate. Homeowners are advised to always have any rebate guarantee in writing in their contract.
