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## FIVE NEVADA CONTRACTORS DISCIPLINED BY CONTRACTORS BOARD

(Reno, NV) - At its meeting on Aug. 13, 2008, the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated

cases involving five contractors.

*All Sierra Electrical, LLC,* license number 51369 (Electrical), based out of Carson City, NV, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to comply with the terms of a construction contract, thereby causing material injury to another; failure to comply with the Board's Notice to Correct; failure to include the Residential Recovery Fund information on a contract or proposal; failure to include the monetary license limit and license number on a contract or proposal; and failure to establish financial responsibility. The licensee was fined \$500 and ordered to pay investigative costs and pay the homeowner \$245. A \$5,000 bond was placed back on the license, and the license limit was reduced to \$500,000.

*Spracklin Construction,* license numbers 41995 and 41995A (Residential & Small Commercial); *Spracklin Tile & Stone*, license number 67313 (Tiling); and *Air Tech Heating & Air Conditioning*, a division of Spracklin Construction, license number 58938A (Air Conditioning), based out of Sparks, NV, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to pay money due for materials or services; failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit; for the partnership, corporation, firm or association participating in a prohibited act; and for failure to establish financial responsibility. The licensee was fined \$4,000, ordered to pay investigative costs, and make full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of t he Residential Recovery Fund. The licensee were revoked.

## Summary Suspension

The Nevada State Contractors Board took proactive action on Aug. 13, 2008, by summarily suspending the following licenses, after several money owing and workmanship complaints were received on the companies:

*Thomas Heath Construction Co.*, license numbers 56528A and 56529A, (Residential & Small Commercial) based out of Santa Barbara, CA. (*Money Owning*)

*E and F Cannon, dba Las Vegas Pools and Spas,* license number 52318 (Masonry) and license number 52318 (Commercial & Residential Pools) based out of Las Vegas, NV. (*Money Owning and Failure to Release a Lien*)

*Brian Hai Kuveke, dba Advanced Air Conditioning*, license number 60623, Refrigeration & Air Conditioning) based out of Henderson, NV. (*Workmanship*)

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to promoting the public confidence and trust in the competency and integrity of licensed contractors and to protecting the health, safety and welfare of the public.

**\*\***The Business Review Program is one in which a contractor's business practices and regulatory compliance is examined by NSCB investigative staff. The program is a part of NSCB's proactive investigative efforts.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.

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
