## **NEVADA CONTRACTOR ADT CONSTRUCTION GROUP, INC.** DISCIPLINED BY CONTRACTORS BOARD

(Henderson, NV) – The Nevada State Contractors Board has adjudicated its case involving ADT Construction Group, Inc.

ADT Construction Group, Inc., license number 53464 (General Building); ADT Construction Group, Inc., dba Advanced Demolition Technologies, license number 50051; (Wrecking Buildings, Unclassified, Removal of Asbestos, Designed for Lead Abatement Only); ADT Construction Group, Inc., dba S&G Fireproofing, license number 50081 (Coatings of Stucco & Cement); and Logic, LLC., license number 70943 (General Building) based out of Las Vegas, NV, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to establish financial responsibility; failure to respond to a written request from the Board; and for the partnership, corporation, firm or association participating in a prohibited act. The licenses 53464, 50051 and 50081 were revoked. Due to the licensee's Chapter 11 bankruptcy, no fines or investigative costs were assessed. Ruben Vasquez was ordered to remove himself as a Member and Qualified Individual (QI) of Logic, LLC., which must find a suitable QI in order for the license to remain active.

\*\*The Business Review Program is one in which a contractor's business practices and regulatory compliance is examined by NSCB investigative staff. The program is a part of NSCB's proactive investigative efforts.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.
