



## Are You Working With Licensed Fire Protection Contractors?

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Nevada Department of Public Safety  
State Fire Marshal Division

The Nevada State Fire Marshal, a division of the Department of Public Safety, is responsible for licensing companies that sell, install or service fire-protection equipment. This includes engineered or pre-engineered fire extinguishing systems, fire alarms / protective signaling systems, automatic fire sprinkler systems, standpipe systems and residential automatic fire sprinkler systems and medical gas installation companies.

The State Fire Marshal investigates complaints against the industry to ensure that qualified companies and/or individuals provide the

installation and service of fire protection equipment. A complete list of current companies is listed at: [www.fire.state.nv.us](http://www.fire.state.nv.us).

The Fire Marshal's office also licenses and certifies companies and individuals who sell and service portable fire extinguishers; interior designers in respect to furniture, fixtures and equipment; pyrotechnic and flame effects companies and technicians and blasters. Anyone working with fire or fire-protection equipment must be licensed or certified by the State Fire Marshal's office.

Nevada contractors are responsible for checking with the State Fire Marshal's office to make sure their correct licenses are in place before doing any work that involves fire protection.

## IRS Announces Economic Stimulus Payment Schedules

The Internal Revenue Service has announced that it will begin sending more than 130 million economic stimulus payments starting May 2. The initial round of weekly payments will be completed by early July.

Stimulus payments will be made by direct deposit to people who choose to receive their 2007 income tax refunds through direct deposit. All others will receive their economic stimulus payments in the form of a paper check.

"To receive an economic stimulus payment, people just need to file their tax returns as they usually do," said IRS Acting Commissioner Linda E. Stiff. "The payments will be automatic for the vast majority of taxpayers. Some lower-income workers and recipients of certain Social Security and veterans benefits who don't normally need to file a tax return will need to do so in order to receive a stimulus payment. IRS.gov has all the information people

need to help them obtain a stimulus payment."

**Stimulus payments will be sent out in the order of the last two digits of the Social Security number used on the tax return.**

Because the IRS will use the Social Security number to determine when checks are mailed, taxpayers may receive their checks at different times than their neighbors, or other family members. On a jointly filed return, the first Social Security number listed will determine the mail-out time.

## ***Prevailing Wage Survey Now Available On the Internet***

LAS VEGAS — The Nevada Labor Commission has released the 2008–2009 Construction Wage Survey for contractors throughout the state.

State law requires the commission to survey contractors who have performed construction work during the past year in order to determine the prevailing wage rates. Prevailing wage rates are required to be paid on all Nevada public works construction projects — such as schools, libraries, roadways and government buildings — costing more than \$100,000.

The surveys are due July 15, 2008, in order for the new rates to be posted by Oct. 1, 2008, as required by Nevada law. In the past, the commission mailed survey packets to licensed contractors across the state. **But this year participants are asked to go online to <http://www.laborcommissioner.com> and complete the form and print a hard copy for mailing. Surveys cannot currently be filed electronically**

Browsers will also find convenient links to Nevada's prevailing wage laws, as well as state-required posters and other useful information on that site.

**Contractors who do not have access to the Internet can still request a hard copy by calling the Office of the Labor**

All contractors who have worked on construction projects may participate in the survey, even if they are not required to have contractors' licenses.

The commission encourages all contractors, particularly those working in rural areas, to participate as precisely as possible in the prevailing wage survey to ensure that the rates established accurately reflect the rates that are being paid in a particular community. If no rates are reported for a craft in a county, the commission must rely on wage rates as reported for the nearest county that has a rate. Many times a low-population county can end up with the same rate as established in Clark County for a particular craft, because no rural numbers were reported. Participation by all contractors is the key.
