GOVERNOR REAPPOINTS CONTRACTORS BOARD MEMBERS JOE HERNANDEZ AND KENT LAY

HENDERSON and RENO, Nev. – Governor Brian Sandoval has announced the reappointment of Nevada State Contractors Board members Kent Lay and Jose "Joe" Hernandez for an additional three-year term, which commences Nov. 1, 2018 to Oct. 31, 2021. In his letter to the returning Board members, Sandoval thanked them for their "commitment to serve Nevada and your fellow citizens."

"It is a true pleasure to have Mr. Hernandez and Mr. Lay remain as members of the Nevada State Contractors Board," NSCB Executive Officer Margi Grein stated. "The expertise and background each brings to the Board will continue to be a valuable asset in our quest to protect the public and give thoughtful consideration to those applying for licensure."

Hernandez is principal and partner in Branch-Hernandez & Associates, Inc. Insurance Services. Originally appointed to the Board in 2013 as the Board's public member, he has more than 40 years' experience as a licensed property and casualty insurance broker and three decades in agency management.

Lay was originally appointed to the Board in 2015. Currently the division president and qualified employee of Woodside Homes of Nevada, he has overseen construction of more than 10,000 homes and hundreds of commercial projects throughout the Southwest in his nearly 30 years in the industry.

The Contractors Board comprises seven members, including six licensed contractors and one representative of the public.
