CONTRACTORS BOARD HIRES RON LYNN AS DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS

HENDERSON, Nev. – The Nevada State Contractors Board announced today that Ronald (Ron) Lynn will begin employment at the Board effective Aug. 22, 2016 as Director of Operations. Lynn joins the Board after a 35-year career with the Clark County Department of Building and Fire Prevention where he served as Building Director/Official.

“It is a great pleasure to welcome Mr. Lynn to the NSCB team,” said NSCB Executive Officer Margi A. Grein. “As a recognized expert in building codes and construction knowledge not only in Las Vegas, but throughout Nevada, the United States, and internationally, we look forward to the innovative and strategic directions he will bring to the Contractors Board as we further serve the health, safety, and welfare of the public and the construction industry as a whole.”

Lynn was hired by the Clark County Department of Building and Fire Prevention in February 1981 to oversee matters of department administration, legal aspects of building codes, finance and management, building codes, building performance standards, and construction issues. His decorated career includes affiliations spanning local to international organizations, including past president of the Board of Directors of the International Code Council (ICC), member of the Board of Directors of the International Accreditation Service, member of the Board of Managers for the International Evaluation Services, Nevada State Hazard Mitigation Planning Steering Committee, the Nevada Bureau of Mines & Geology Advisory Committee, and was appointed to the National Earthquake Hazards Reduction Program Federal Advisory Committee on Earthquake Hazards Reduction by the National Institute of Standards & Technology.

Recent accomplishments of Lynn include being recognized in 2009 by the United States Congress for his contributions in building safety and awarded the Senatorial Commendation for his commitment to building safety, energy conservation, and emergency response in 2010. In 2014, he received the Community Achievement Award by the Asian American Group, the Government Person of the Year Award by the International Association of Plumbing & Mechanical Officials, and the 2014 Western States Seismic Policy

Council Lifetime Achievement Award. The International Code Council recognized Lynn with its highest award, the prestigious Bobby J. Fowler Award, in 2015 for his career of leadership in the building safety industry to achieve a safer built environment.
