## **SIX NEVADA CONTRACTORS DISCIPLINED** **BY CONTRACTORS BOARD**

*(Henderson, NV)* – At its meeting on July 23, 2008, the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated cases involving six contractors.

---

*Mike William White, dba All Phase Electric*, license number 56798 (Electrical), based out of Henderson, NV, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to establish financial responsibility. The licensee was ordered to pay investigative costs and continue making payments to the materials supplier.

---

*A.S.A.P. Maintenance, Inc., dba DFS Flooring*, license number 67217 (Finishing Floors), based out of Las Vegas, NV, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for misrepresentation of a material fact and failure to establish financial responsibility. The licensee was fined \$200, ordered to pay investigative costs, pay the homeowner \$5,694 in restitution and provide a current financial statement to support the license limit. The license was suspended.

*Condor Business Solutions, LLC, dba El Sol Marble & Tile*, license number 68196 (Install Terazzo & Marble), based out of Las Vegas, NV, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship; failure to take appropriate corrective action and failure to comply to a written citation within the time permitted for compliance. The licensee was fined \$1,150, ordered to pay investigative costs and \$15,000 in restitution to the homeowner. The license was revoked..

*VMS Builders, Inc.*, license number 67833 (General Building), based out of Orlando, FL, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to obtain the discharge of a lien; diversion of funds; failure to pay money due for materials or services rendered; failure to respond to a written request from the Board; failure to establish financial responsibility; and failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit. The licensee was fined \$4,000; ordered to pay investigative costs; and make full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund. The license was revoked.

***Sure Rock, Inc.***, license number 58777 (Masonry), based out of Las Vegas, NV, was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to establish financial responsibility; failure to respond to a written request from the Board; and failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit. The licensee was fined \$1,500; ordered to pay investigative costs; and make full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund. The license was revoked.

**Summary Suspension**

The Nevada State Contractors Board took proactive action on July 23, 2008, by summarily suspending the following license, after several money owing and abandonment complaints were received on the company:

***Cabo Enterprises, LLC, dba Cabo Pools & Spas***, license number 58881, (Commercial & Residential Pools and Excavating, Grading, Trenching & Surfacing) based out of Las Vegas, NV.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to promoting the public confidence and trust in the competency and integrity of licensed contractors and to protecting the health, safety and welfare of the public.

***The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.***
