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NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD REVOKES SEVEN LICENSES OF THREE COMPANIES

LAS VEGAS and RENO, NEV. – The Nevada State Contractors Board took disciplinary action against licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its April hearings, including seven license revocations and multiple assessments of fines and costs.

Disciplinary action may consist of a fine, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.

The NSCB has the responsibility to promote quality construction by Nevada licensed contractors through a regulatory licensing system designed to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public.
