



# NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD NEWS RELEASE

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## CONTRACTORS BOARD REVOKES FOUR LICENSES DURING RECENT DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

**LAS VEGAS and RENO, NEV.** – The Nevada State Contractors Board took disciplinary action against licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its August 2024 hearings resulting in the issuance of over \$730,000 in fines and the revocation of four licenses.
