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MINUTES OF THE MEETING August 21, 2025

CALL TO ORDER:

Mr. Behar read the Board's mission statement into the record: "The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to ensuring the integrity and professionalism of the construction industry in Nevada. The NSCB has the responsibility to promote quality construction by Nevada licensed contractors through a regulatory licensing system designed to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public."

6. EXECUTIVE SESSION

a. Executive Officer's Report

Mr. Behar noted that in July, the Board experienced significant visibility and media engagement, including interviews with Channel 3 and Channel 13 addressing contractor scams during monsoon and fire season, with Board Member Louis Polish providing valuable tips on avoiding unlicensed contractors. The Nevada Current and Las Vegas Review Journal also published coverage on the AB227 ruling, where the Board reiterated its commitment to statutory compliance and transparency. Staff appreciation was highlighted through ice cream socials in both offices and recognition of employees with five or more years of service. Mr. Behar reported that he attended the Nevada Contractors Association's Contractor of the Year Awards Luncheon, where former Board Member Kevin Burke was honored with multiple awards, and also participated in a collaborative meeting with the Nevada Office of Boards, Commissions, and Councils Standards. Additionally, Mr. Behar stated that he met with Amber Steidham, the new Southern Nevada Director of the Governor's Office, to discuss Board goals and initiatives. This month marked the start of the Boards licensing internship program with Employ NV, welcoming Arianna Spencer as our first intern.

b. Review of Monthly Department Statistics:

Mr. Behar provided the following statistics for the month of July:

- Licensing Department:
 - · Received 267 new license applications and 288 change applications;
 - Issued 165 new licenses:
 - Approved 737 license renewal applications;
 - Renewed and issued 49 Certificates of Eligibility to receive preference in bidding; and
 - Hosted 1 online Business Assistance Program with 8 participants in attendance.
 - There are currently 1,116 license applications and 583 change applications pending.
- Investigations Department:
 - Held 9 Disciplinary Hearings, where 15 cases were heard.
 - 8 Recovery Fund claims were opened and one Recovery Fund meetings was held in the month of July where \$150,636 was awarded to 10 harmed homeowners.
- Compliance Division:
 - Received and opened 113 complaints and closed 159 complaints, issuing 10 Administrative Citations.
 - As of July 31st, there are 527 compliance complaints open active with an average of 172 days open.
- Criminal Division:
 - Received 60 complaints and closed 40 complaints, issuing 11 Administrative Citations.
 - One case was sent to the local District Attorney's office.
 - 69 Criminal complaints are open-active with the average days open being 61.

One case is pending adjudication in the month of July.
