CONTRACTORS BOARD DISCIPLINARY HEARING OUTCOMES FEBRUARY 2026

LAS VEGAS and RENO, NEV. – The Nevada State Contractors Board took disciplinary action against licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its February 2026 hearings.

Disciplinary action may consist of a fine, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.
