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- Respondent's counsel objected to inclusion of documents related to settlement negotiations regarding the Akiyama matter.

- Respondent's counsel moved for a directed verdict regarding Complainant Herder, and the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) deferred ruling on the motion. The ALJ indicated the issue remains under consideration and the Board's authority may extend to fraudulent conduct tangential to construction activity. His ruling would be in his final Decision and Order. The ALJ also stated the evidentiary portion of the hearing was closed and stayed his ruling for final determination regarding jurisdiction and merits of the fraud and misrepresentation allegations. After a brief off-the-record meeting (10:27 a.m. to 10:39 a.m.) between the Prosecutor and Respondent's attorney, the parties agreed to continue the hearing for 30 days to April 22, 2026. The Board will Notice the Hearing.
