CALL TO ORDER

Administrative Law Judge Noah Allison, Esq., called the meeting of the State Contractors Board to order on **April 22, 2026 at 8:30 a.m.**, at the offices of the State Contractors Board in Las Vegas, Nevada, with simultaneous audio and video participation in Reno, Nevada.

Executive Officer David Behar, stated the agenda was posted in compliance with the Open Meeting Law at both offices of the Board, on the Board's Internet website, the Nevada Public Notice website, and e-mailed electronically to persons who have expressed interest in being kept informed of the Board's meetings.

 - Due to the Respondent's admission of guilt to ALL the allegations; the Board recommends nominal fines, guilt across the board with fees and costs to be assessed by the Board within Sixty (60) days of the Decision and Order.
 - The **ALJ ORDERS** that based on admissions of guilt from the Respondent, Respondent is found to be in violation of:
 - Allegation #1 with a fine of \$500;
 - Allegation #2 and fined \$1,000;
 - Allegation #3 and fined \$500;
 - Allegations #4 and #5 are affirmed;
 - Allegation #6 with nominal fines;
 - Total of fines in the amount of \$2,000;
 - That license numbers 88954 and 86589 are immediately suspended;
 - Failure to reimburse the Residential Recovery Fund (if awarded) will result in revocation of license.
 - The ALJ ORDERED that fees, fines and costs to be paid within sixty (60) days of the Decision and Order.

 - Respondent Montis Construction, LLC is not in business, with no projects. The status of Montis Construction, LLC, license number 87682, is currently "*cancelled not renewed*" and no action will be taken against this license;
 - The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) **ORDERS** that since the Board failed to prove participation and with no sufficient evidence, nor having any knowledge of Premier / PHC, there will be no discipline against Iconic; the Board failed to prove by a preponderance of evidence that Respondent Charlene Paiement (Iconic Landscape and Development, Inc.) had knowledge or participation in any of the prohibited acts; no discipline will be assessed against Respondent Iconic Landscape and Development, Inc.;
 - Charlene Paiement need not be removed from the license of Iconic Landscape;
 - That Christopher Bacon is to be removed from Iconic Landscaping license information;
 - The **ALJ FURTHER FINDS** that the Notice of Stay on Premier Home Construction Inc., dba PHC Builders is moot as the Nevada State Contractors Board is a government entity and therefore is not subject to the rules of a bankruptcy stay per NRS 624.005, 11 U.S.C. 362(a), 11 U.S.C. 362(b), and 11 U.S.C. 362(b)(4), "*the automatic stay from bankruptcy petitions "do not operate as a stay" to government units exercising their police and regulatory powers to commence or continue with an action or proceeding to protect the public health and safety.*";
 - **The ALJ FURTHER FINDS AND ORDERS** that the Respondent Premier Home Construction, Inc. dba PHC, is in violation of ALL allegations and minimal fines will be assessed in the Decision and Order due to the large quantity of allegations and causes of action;
 - **That license number 64079 is immediately revoked;**
 - As there was no Answer filed and a Notice of Default served on PHC only, fines, fees and costs will be assessed; that the amounts of the minimal files will be stated in the Decision and Order which will be provided within the next several weeks;
 - Christopher Bacon is to be removed from Iconic Landscaping and Development, Inc.'s license immediately.

 - the Respondent is required to provide the Board Compliance Investigator, Josue Barrera, confirmation of the payment and cabinet door delivery;
 - that **license number 87989 is immediately suspended** until Respondent has provided compliant financials to the Board;
 - The **ALJ FINDS AND ORDERS** that Respondent is
 - in violation of Allegation #1 with a minimum fine to be determined after confirmation of the \$5,000;
 - in violation of Allegation #2 with a minimum fine to be determined after confirmation of the \$5,000;
 - in violation of Allegation #3 with a minimum fine to be determined after confirmation of the \$5,000;
 - in violation of Allegation #4 with a minimum fine to be determined after confirmation of the \$5,000;
 - Allegation #5 **affirmed** if applicable;
 - Allegation #6 is **affirmed**;
 - in violation of Allegation #7 with a minimum fine to be determined after confirmation of the \$5,000;
 - The ALJ states that Allegation #7 will be dismissed if the original Administrative Citation is paid in full within thirty (30) days.
 - **License number 87989 is suspended until compliant financials are provided to the Board. Suspension will be lifted after the financials are received and support the Respondent's monetary limit.**




There being no further business to come before the Board, the disciplinary hearing was adjourned at **12:13 p.m.** by Administrative Law Judge Noah Allison, Esq.
