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COMMISSION ON CONSTRUCTION EDUCATION INVESTS IN THE FUTURE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

LAS VEGAS and RENO, NEV. – The Nevada Commission on Construction Education (CCE) was established by the Nevada Legislature in 2001 to strengthen the future of Nevada’s construction workforce. The Commission is responsible for reviewing educational programs related to the construction industry and awarding grants from the Construction Education Account to qualified organizations that provide career awareness, workforce development, and construction education opportunities.

The Commission administers grants to eligible applicants, including governmental entities, nonprofit organizations recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3), and nonprofit educational institutions, that prepare students and young adults for rewarding careers in the construction industry. During its biannual meetings, the Commission reviews and evaluates grant applications that promote construction education, increase industry awareness, and encourage enrollment in construction-related training programs.

The Commission consists of seven members: one current representative from the NSCB and six members appointed by the Governor, including four representatives from the construction industry and two members with expertise in construction education.

Funding for the Construction Education Account comes from administrative fines through investigations, as well as voluntary donations from licensed contractors, industry associations, and other supporters who recognize the importance of investing in Nevada’s future workforce.

During Fiscal Year 2025-2026, more than 100 contractors generously contributed to the Construction Education Account. Their support helped provide educational opportunities for hundreds of students and young adults interested in pursuing careers in the construction industry, allowing them to gain valuable skills, participate in hands-on training, and develop into the next generation of builders, craftsmen, supervisors, and business leaders.

The Commission encourages additional contractors, construction companies, and industry partners to consider making a voluntary donation to the CCE Account. Every contribution directly supports programs that introduce students to the construction trades, strengthen Nevada’s skilled workforce, and help meet the growing demand for qualified construction professionals across the state.

“This is an outstanding opportunity for contractors and industry leaders to invest in the future of Nevada’s workforce,” said NSCB Chairman Louis Polish, Jr. “Every donation helps create opportunities for students to explore careers in construction, develop valuable skills, and build successful futures in one of our state’s most essential industries.
