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### CONTRACTORS BOARD DISCIPLINARY HEARING OUTCOMES MAY 2026

**LAS VEGAS and RENO, NEV.** – The Nevada State Contractors Board took disciplinary action against licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its May 2026 hearings.
