The purpose of the meetings is to receive and discuss stakeholder feedback, recommendations, and suggestions. No action will be taken at the meetings as there will not be a quorum of Board Members present.

Pursuant to Section 1 of the Executive Order, the Board must:

1. Solicit from those stakeholders' recommendations regarding regulations that should be streamlined, clarified, or removed;
2. Undertake a comprehensive review of the regulations subject to its enforcement; and
3. Identify other regulatory changes the Board determines worthy of consideration.

Stakeholders wishing to comment may appear at the scheduled stakeholder meetings and may provide their comments, data, recommendations and/or suggestions. Comments will be limited to three minutes per stakeholder.

After receiving stakeholder comments pursuant to subsection 1 of Section 1 of the Executive Order, Board staff will substantively review the regulations discussed and/or proposed for revision or removal during the meetings and prepare a report for the Board to discuss and potentially act upon at a future Board meeting where further public comment will be possible.
